What should I report?



Any concern about a child's wellbeing



If you think a child may not be safe or is at risk



Anything that doesn't align with Playgroup Tasmania's Child Safety Policy or Code of Conduct

Who can report?

Children or young people

Parents or caregivers

Staff or volunteers

When to report?



Immediately if a child is in danger – call **000**



No immediate danger? Within 24 hours of noticing a concern

Who do I report to?



If a child is at immediate risk, call Police **000** or **131 444**



Strong Families Safe Kids: **1800 000 123**

Crime Stoppers: **1800 333 000**



Your Playgroup Tasmania contact, who will notify the CEO

What happens next?

Police or support services may be contacted

Everyone's safety and wellbeing will be checked

Support and counselling will be offered
